Christy's Story

My name is Christy Trembly and I am 31 years old. I was born and raised in Baltimore Maryland, and then at the age of 15 my family moved us to Dover, PA. I struggled my whole life with wanting to be loved and accepted by my biological father to the

point of losing sight of who I was and what I was worth. I began looking for love in other men and became pregnant for the first time when I was 25 years old. I now have six children, but in 2016 I signed my rights over for 2 of them. This cycle of no self worth, low self esteem, drug use, and domestic abuse led to a life of destruction. I entered New Life for Girls for the first time in June 2013 and graduated October 2014, but I never fully applied God's Word in my life and I refused to give Him complete control. I moved in with my sister and shortly after the drug use began. I entered into an abusive relationship with my youngest son's father, but I stayed because he was the band aid covering how I truly felt about myself. Finally I had enough and entered NLFG a second time on March 2, 2017. I started allowing contact with my son's father again, and fell shortly after having to leave NLFG. I entered a world of full blown addiction and abuse. Child Services became involved and by the grace of God I was given wisdom and strength to get myself and the 2 children I have custody of into Gaudenzia Vantage Intensive Rehab for mothers with kids. I voluntarily completed 6 months of rehab, and then transferred back to New Life for Mothers and Children. Only God could have opened that door for me because no one wanted to deal with me any longer, but God made a way when there seemed to be no way. I came back October 4, 2018 and have allowed the Holy Spirit total access into my life. I continue to persevere daily no matter how hard it gets because today I can say I'm living for Him and I know that He has great things in store for me. It is His will for my life, not my own!
